After its assessment and accreditation by NAAC, the institution has very sincerely prepared its strategic plan and perspective plan to streamline various curricular and co-curricular activities. The management and the administration have adopted a robust and transparent to deploy the plan prepared. This is reflected in our planning, execution and remedial actions taken at all the functional levels of the institute viz: Academic level and the Administrative level. Besides the IQAC of the Institute, in consultation and appropriate involvement of all the Stakeholders has devised an extensive perspective plan of the Institute to be executed during the span of 2017 up to 2021. The sole intention of this perspective plan is to adhere to the Vision and Mission of the NAAC, affiliating University, Regulatory bodies and as result strengthen the quality of education provided for all the UG, PG and Research Sectors of our Institute. The College under the leadership of the Principal, identified major strategic / perspective plans & imperatives and employed necessary efforts to improve the thrust areas like:-

- 1. Enhanced Teaching and Learning methodology-** Teachers update themselves through refresher, capacity building program, faculty development program, and are using ICT in their teaching method.
- 2. Introduction of New Academic Programmes-** Started B.COM IN 2017
- 3. Improving Infrastructural Facilities-** Full automated Library, and six classroom constructed under RUSA Scheme.
- 4. Enhancing Research activities-** Three research center [Hindi, Sociology and Political Science] actively functioning in which nine PH.D Research Scholars are enrolled.
- 5. Employability of the Students-** Many students started their own entrepreneurial ventures, got selected in government and non government institutions through our career guidance program.
- 6. Co-Curricular Activities-** Project work, dissertation, social outreach.
- 7. MoU and collaboration with other institutions-** Rajeev Gandhi govt P.G College Ambikapur, Govt Science College Ambikapur, Saraswati Mahavidyalaya Ambikapur and many other institutions.
- 8. Extra-Curricular Activities-** NSS, YOUTH RED CROSS, RED RIBBON, ECO CLUB
- 9. Mobilization of non-Governmental Funds**

There is also Community Engagement as follows:-

- 1. Regular Field Work by NSS-** The NSS students are placed for regular activity in the college campus. Many times they carry out community development activities in the community.
